He volunteers his time by helping repair and up-grade their building.

Frederick Tymeson, has been a volunteer Firefighter with the Allendale County Volunteer Fire Department for the past 28 years. During the Christmas holidays Fred and his family spend time with security personnel assigned to SRS perimeter barricades. In 2007, Officer Tymeson underwent surgery and donated one of his kidneys to a friend and fellow firefighter who was suffering from a potentially life-threatening medical condition.
