WACKENHUT DONATES \$2500 TO AIKEN HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

AIKEN, S.C. – Wackenhut Services Incorporated, the security contractor at the Department of Energy's Savannah River Site, has donated \$2500 to support the Aiken Habitat for Humanity.

Aiken County Habitat for Humanity is a non-profit organization that builds and mortgages houses to approved low-income families on a no-profit, no-interest basis. Relying on a unique partnership of individual volunteers, skilled craftsmen, churches, businesses, and homeowners themselves, Habitat constructs simple, decent family homes and then finances them over a 15-25 year period. Mortgage payments, in turn, go to producing additional housing. The Aiken volunteer base consists of elected officials, business leaders, presidents and executives of large corporations, retirees and people from all walks of life.



"We're excited to partner with the Aiken Habitat for Humanity in this initiative to positively impact lives in our local community," said Randy Garver, Wackenhut's General Manager at SRS. Savannah River Site

The Savannah River Site is a key DOE industrial complex dedicated to environmental management and cleanup, nuclear weapons stockpile stewardship, and nuclear materials disposition in support of the U.S. nuclear non-proliferation efforts. The 310-square-mile site also develops and deploys technologies to support the environmental cleanup and energy independence. The site's center is approximately 23 miles southeast of Augusta, Georgia, and 20 miles south of Aiken, South Carolina, the two closest population centers. WSI has provided security services at SRS since 1983.
